## Spotlight on Honors It's Time to Consider Candidates for PSA Honors

Yes, it is once again the time to consider fellow members of the Photographic Society of America (PSA) as candidates for Honors. Is there a PSA member in camera club, the Chapter or a PSA Division that has been working for photography, clubs, councils, chapters and maybe even for the Society for years? Has no one seemed to notice the activity of a fellow member? Take the initiative and plan to submit a candidate and locate two endorsers. First step in the process: Obtain the application. Proposing a candidate for Honors requires a current Honors Application form. Request the Application for 2014's candidates from PSA Headquarters: mail, phone or email. The Operations Manager will send out the current application for this year's deadline upon request. The annual Due Date for applications to be received at PSA Headquarters is December 1st. The application must be mailed to Headquarters offices in Oklahoma City to arrive by that date. Important: Make note that an application may no longer be emailed, but will need to be sent hard-copy to Headquarters, therefore plan the timing carefully! A head and shoulders photograph of the candidate is to be included with the application (please, no hats nor cats nor picket fences in the picture). If the candidate is elected by the Honors Committee, the photo will be used for the *PSA Journal* announcement following the conference in Albuquerque.

Ask the candidate to give a list of dated activities. As proposer, then organize the activity list, and carefully prepare the application according to directions, using the current 2013 form. Obtain a photo, gather two signed endorser's statements and send everything in one envelope to PSA Headquarters. *Service to photography is key to election!*

(There is no longer a fee to apply for Associate, Fellow, Honorary Member, nor Honorary Fellow!)
