# On the PSA Website

## PSA Journal Online

If you're reading this article in PSA's print *Journal*, you're already familiar with one way to access the *PSA Journal*. But the *Journal* is also available on the website, in whole and in part, for PSA individual members.

### PSA Journal Search

Do you remember a specific article but can't remember where you saw it? Do you want to locate the issues that covered a specific event back in the 1950s? Then use our *Journal Search* function. *Journal Search* is open to the public and does not require membership in PSA as it only provides reference material (but not the actual articles or journals). Maintained by PSA Members **Laura Davies, HonPSA**, with assistance from **Belinda Keller**, the *Journal Search* is found under the *PSA Journal* tab (second row under the logo). You can search by date, title, author's name, or keyword through issues dating back to 1934.

### PSA Journal in PDF

Many individual members do not receive a print version, but only read the *Journal* online. Downloading and reading a pdf of the *Journal* is one of the options for online reading. PDFs of the journal can be found through the My PSA section and is reached through logging in at the home page or through the left column button that says "Member Login." The right column of My PSA is titled *PSA Journal & Selected Columns* and the first option is for the *PSA Journal Online*. The page always begins with the most current issue's cover image, and beside it are links to its PDF. On this same page, you can find all of the *PSA Journals* back to 2007. Note: the 2007 *Journals* were scanned from the print version, so the quality may not be as clear as the 2008 and forward *Journals*.

### PSA Journal Mobile

Beginning in 2013, the *PSA Journal* has been available as a mobile edition as well. This version can be read on Android, Windows, and Apple devices, including smart phones and tablets. An interactive version, its pages can be flipped (with or without sound—your choice!) and read on the go. This version requires an internet connection. The mobile version of the *Journal* is reached the same way you would reach the PDF versions and is identified by the word "mobile." Issues beginning in 2013 and onward contain two links below their date: pdf and mobile. Once you've opened a mobile version many options are available, all accessible from the eight icons that head the page. The first icon allows you to download a PDF of the issue. Choose the second to crop and download a section of a page; the third to print a single page, range of pages, or the entire *Journal*; the fourth will translate the page you are on (it is rudimentary, but it works!); the fifth adjusts the settings to play a flipping sound, show link tooltips, play the pages as a slide show, or show the page's shadow (easier to read); the sixth adds a bookmark; the seventh puts your notes on pages; and the eighth switches to single page mode (the last icon).

### Specific Journal Articles

If you have been following a favorite columnist, you might want to review his or her articles from former *Journals*. You can do this by reading the entire back *Journals* (from 2007 forward) or you can access PDFs of the columnist's articles through My PSA. You can see articles from Just for Beginners, Questions and Answers (Photographic Equipment and Techniques), Photoshop/Lightroom Tips & Techniques, and PSA and Video. We also have articles from discontinued columns: Benefits of Social Networks and Social Networking for Photographers. *PSA Journal Travel* articles are also available through My PSA, but under the heading Travel. ■
