- * How well did the first photographs draw you into the story?
- * Rate the introduction.
- * Rate the plot.
- * Rate the Conclusion.
- * How clear was the theme or storyline in this essay?
- * How well did the music enhance the story?
- * How well did the text enhance the story?
- * How well did the narration enhance the story?
- * How well did the special effects enhance the story?
- * Rate the appropriateness of the pacing for the story.
- * Rate the sequence and flow of the images.
- * Rate the lack of redundancy.
- * Rate what you learned.
- * How well did the essay hold your attention?
- * Rate the quality of the images used (e.g., in focus, correctly exposed, adequate post-production).
- * How strong was the last impression?
- * Rate the quality of the transitions.
- * If Monochrome: Rate the appropriateness of the topic, theme, and/or story to be told using Monochrome.
- * If Color: Rate the appropriateness of the topic, theme, and/or story to be told using Color.
- * Score the Storyline (Score X 2).
- * Score the Presentation (Score X 2).
